For Homeowners â€” Design Your Kitchen in 5 Minutes

1. **Visit the homepage and try the 3D sample.** No sign-in needed. Drag the sample cabinets around, rotate the view, and get a feel for how the design tool works. This takes less than a minute.
2. **Start a new room.** Choose how you want to begin: upload a photo of your current kitchen, measure your space and enter the dimensions, or describe your vision in a guided chat. We'll help you capture the basics.
3. **Lay out your cabinets in live 3D.** Drag cabinets into your space, arrange them, and watch the 3D view update instantly. You'll see exactly how your kitchen will look.
4. **Pick your style.** Choose door styles, finishes, hardware, and accessories. Prices update in real time as you make choices, so you always know what you're spending.
5. **Request your quote.** Once you're happy with your design, request a formal PDF quote in just a few clicks. A Southbrook specialist will review it and get back to you.

For Trade & Dealer Partners â€” Build an Order

1. **Sign in to your partner account.** Access the Order Builder, where you can manage all your customer quotes and orders in one place.
2. **Create a new order and add zones.** Start fresh or copy a recent design. Add one or more kitchen zones â€” main cabinets, island, pantry, whatever your client needs.
3. **Configure each line.** For each zone, select cabinet types, door styles, finishes, hardware, and accessories. You'll see your channel-specific pricing as you go.
4. **Check the pricing for your channel.** Dealer pricing varies by channel. See exactly what your margin is and what your client will pay.
5. **Preview the bill of materials.** Review the parts list for your order â€” every cabinet, hinge, handle, and finish is spelled out clearly. No surprises on the factory floor.
6. **Send the quote or confirm the order.** Export a professional quote to send to your customer, or move the order straight to confirmed and into our production pipeline. Lead time is 4â€“6 weeks from confirmation.

Tips

- **Start with a photo or room sketch.** The better the detail you give us upfront, the more accurate your design. Photos work especially well.
- **Live pricing is your friend.** Change a door style, add an island, swap a finish â€” the price updates instantly. You can explore what-ifs without committing.
- **Save your design so you don't lose it.** If you're browsing on a phone and want to continue on desktop, or if you want to come back tomorrow, sign in and save. It's all there waiting.
